Sipoo

Relax and experience the nature, archipelago and the countryside. Enjoy the peace of nature in Sipoonkorpi's National Park or ride through the wavy cornfields.

Take a dip at the beaches or experience the archipelago aboard a RIB boat. Catch fish, play golf, play frisbee or go climbing in the adventure park. Feel the medieval atmosphere of Sipoo's old church and immerse yourself in the unique cultural landscape that the old church and Sipoo's neo-Gothic church create together.

Or walk through the old buildings of former Nikkilä's mental hospital on routes that thousands of patients have trodden. Enjoy concerts, art exhibitions or unique village events. Enjoy Sipoo's cafe and restaurant services, atmospheric accommodations as well as hobby- and experience services. You are welcome to oceanic and forested Sipoo!



Sipoonkorpi

Sipoonkorpi is a national park and the woodiest forest in Finland, which offers excellent deep forests, mushroom- and berry fields, gently flowing rivers and birdsongs only 24 kilometers from the center of Helsinki.

On the edges of Sipoonkorpi there are beautiful villages in the middle of traditional landscapes. You can ski, hike, bike, climb, or look for geocaches and above all relax in the forest. Sipoonkorpi is suitable for all ages. The shortest route is called Byabäcken nature trail that is 1.4 km long, which runs through Byabäcken forests.

For a true hiker, there is enough to hike for several days. Sipoonkorpi is easy to reach from all directions. If you arrive with your own car, there are several parking areas for you, but you can easily get to Finland's woodiest forest by bicycle as well. In

the 2023 summer season, hikers will also be served by the Sipoonkorpi Hop-On Hop-Off bus on the weekends. The last stops are Tikkurila's travel center and Mellunmäki metro station.

An entrance gate called Korvenportti has been developed on the edge of Sipoonkorpi in the village of Hindsby, which' services enable you unforgettable nature experiences and breaking away from everyday life for both day trips and longer trips. There is already a parking lot, but accommodation and storage facilities are planned for the area for nature entrepreneurs.

Archipelago

Blue glistening water, deserted windswept cliffs and delicacies from the harbor kiosk. In Sipoo we have a large archipelago with several recreational areas available for everyone.

Enjoy snacks by the campfire, paddle to the sandy beach on a hot day, enjoy the sun on a sup-board in the coastal waters or snare the catch of a lifetime.

Sipoo's archipelago can also be reached without a boat. You can easily get there with connecting ships, rental boats, rental kayaks or even jet skis.

Destinations in the archipelago

The destinations in the archipelago are freely accessible outdoor recreational areas where you can find fireplaces for preparing barbecue delicacies with dining groups and neat wooden toilets.

Norrkullalandet

Norrkullalandet is Sipoo's archipelago's most popular excursion destination. It can be reached by free ships, operated by Pörtö Line ships from the mainland to Norrkullaland up to four times a day! Enjoy the sun on several rocky and sandy beaches as well as grilling summer delicacies at barbecue places. Walk on a nature trail to the observation tower. From here you can see the entire Sipoo archipelago all the way to the open sea.

Möholmen

A popular excursion destination in Möholmen is located right next to the port of Kalkkiranta. Magnificent cliffs and sandy beaches are waiting for you. There is plenty of space for campers and there are wonderful views from the high cliffs. It is easy to land in Möholmen by boat, you can just drag the small boat to a sandy beach.

Vilstrand, Söderkullalandet

Sipoo municipality's recreational center that's located closest to the mainland is easily accessible. You can get there by rowing or kayaking from Gumbostrand harbor. Overnight stay is possible in a tent, and under a large canopy where a larger group can fit under the rain cover. The tent can be set up facing the sunset on the island of Simalö.

Östholmen

Östholmen is a destination for the whole family in the outer archipelago, where you can spend time either in the form of a day trip or staying overnight in a tent. The island is a popular place for boaters. The best way to get to Östholmen is by boat. When the weather is really good, you can also paddle on the sandy beach.

Many people think that the most beautiful sunsets can be seen in Östholmen. Tip: The rocks on the west side! The pearl of the Furuholm archipelago with wonderful open sea views! Landing with a bigger boat is also possible due to the depth of the water.



Furuholmen

The pearl of the outer archipelago with wonderful open sea views! Furuholmen is in a really windy place in Sipoonselkä, but the landing site is located in a sheltered lagoon. Even a big boat can land at this place because of the deep water.

Simsalö

Simsalö is one of the longest inhabited islands in the Sipoo archipelago, where there has been a significant local presence population center since the Middle Ages. Simsalö has always been important as a regional center. Today, twenty families live on the island all year round. Until the 20th century Simsalö's role as the civilizer of southern Sipoo was really important, because children from the mainland who lived on the coast came to Simsalö's school. The importance of Simsalö is still important, even though most of the residents are summer residents.

Culture and art

Sipoo has been inhabited since the Stone Age. The Sipoo of the 2020s is a vibrant cultural keeper, which is proud of its roots but constantly evolving. We stick to our traditions, but our eyes are boldly on the future.

Landscape of Nikkilä's Mental Hospital

The large mental hospital in Sipoo was a place where the most difficult and sick patients were transferred. Many lived in the hospital for years, some until the end of their life. The hospital stopped operating in 1999, but you can still walk through the old buildings of former Nikkilä's mental hospital on routes that thousands of patients have trodden.

Please note that the area is now a residential area and the houses are people's homes. Please respect the residents and do not go into private yards or stairwells. Also, please leave your car parked outside the area in public parking spaces. Move around the area on foot.



Culture-Sipoo

Experience Sipoo's vibrant, unique and comprehensive cultural life. Homeland love, music, theater, art and various experiences are offered all year round in two languages. During event weekends, you can experience anything! You can experience surprising and fun events. There is an art gallery, an art loan office and art education in the Nikkilä's mental hospital area.

Churches

Sipoo is an exceptional municipality in the sense that there are two magnificent churches located right next to each other in the center of Nikkilä. The churches are only a few hundred meters apart and together form a unique cultural landscape.

The Old Church of Sipoo, also known as St. Sigfrid's Church, was built in the 1450s. The medieval grey stone church is very popular as a wedding church during the summer, and summer worship services are also held there. The designer of the church is unknown, but he is known as the so-called Master of Pernaja. Its architecture differs from other medieval stone churches in Finland, as its choir is built as a three-aisled church, while the rest of the church is double-aisled.

In the Old Church, one can still feel the atmosphere of the Middle Ages. The walls and vaults are decorated with paintings made with red ochre

and soot in the 1400s. The church also houses a pillory in the church hall and a penitential bench in the armory (entrance hall), dating back to the 1600s and 1700s. The newer Sipoo Church, designed by Theodor Decker, is a mostly neo-Gothic style red brick church. It was built when the old church became too small for the growing congregation in the 1800s. The church was consecrated in 1885 and is used by both the Finnish and Swedish congregations of Sipoo.

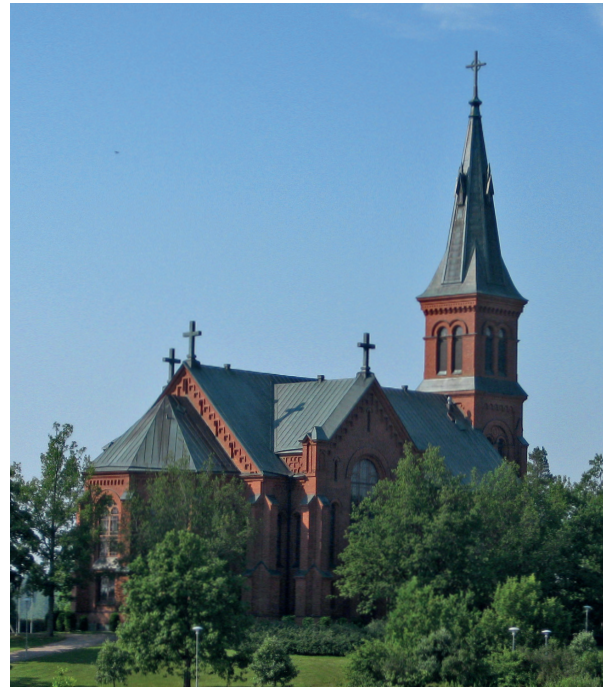

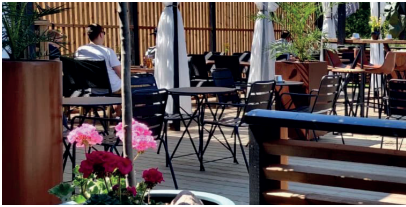

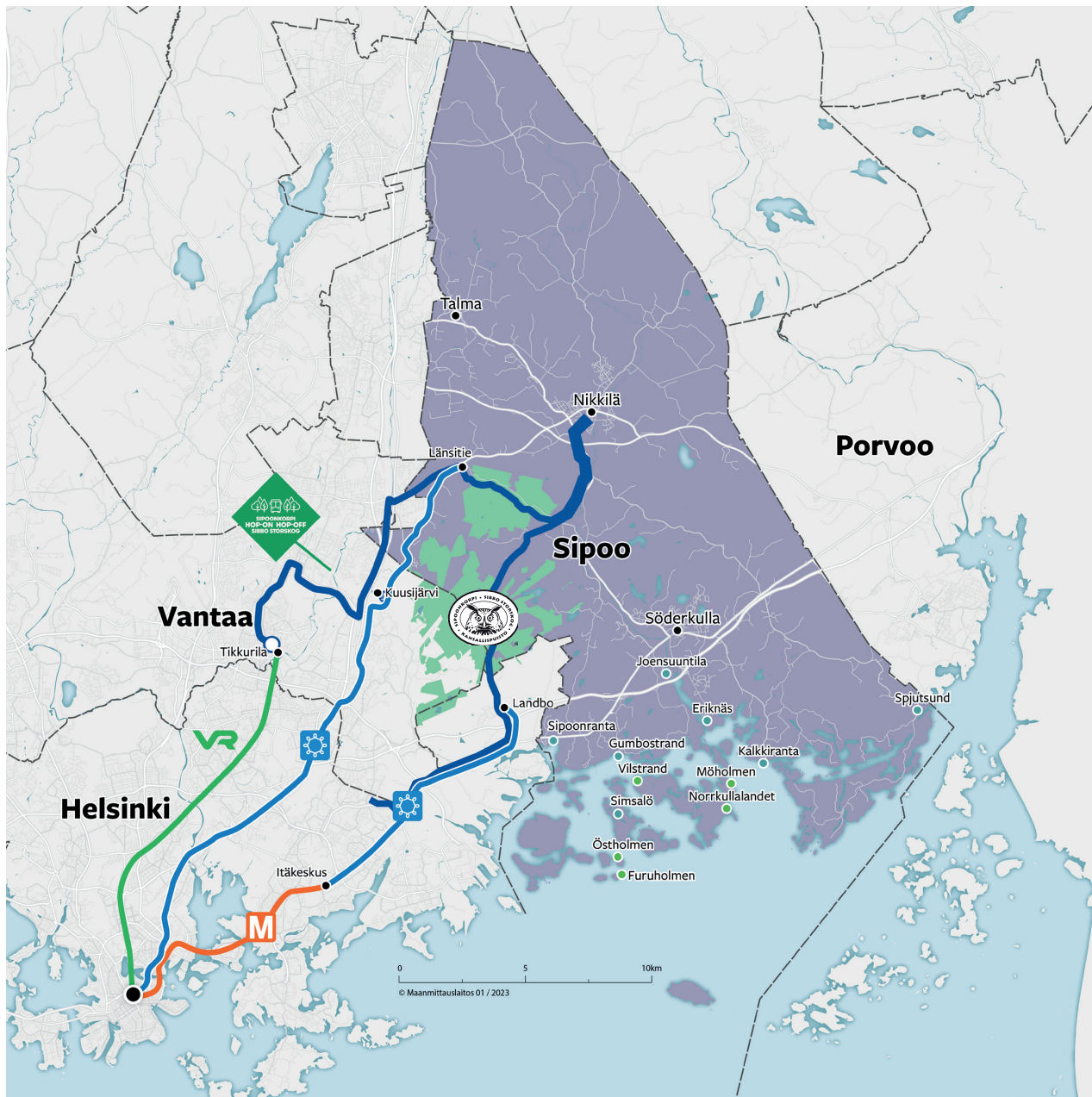
Hop-on Hop-Off Bus in Sipoonkorpi

The Sipoonkorpi Hop-On Hop-Off bus will once again take hikers to nature from May 13 to October 1, 2023. The bus travels around Sipoonkorpi on Saturdays and Sundays between Nikkilä, Tikkurila, and Mellunmäki, stopping at a total of ten stops.

Sounds like a great opportunity to explore the beautiful nature of Sipoonkorpi! The updated route and schedule for the Sipoonkorpi Hop-On Hop-Off bus are available for you to check out. The bus runs with a low-floor bus, and it can accommodate four strollers at a time. You are also allowed to bring your dog on the bus.

The reittiliikenne (route traffic) is managed by Taksikuljetus Oy in collaboration with the municipalities of Sipoo and Vantaa. Don't miss the chance to hop on the bus and enjoy the lush forests of Sipoonkorpi, the most forested area in Finland!
