Sipoonkorpi



Sipoonkorpi is a national park and the most wooded forest in Finland, which offers deep wilderness, mushroom and berry fields, gently flowing rivers, and birdsong, only 24 kilometres from the centre of Helsinki.

On the edges of Sipoonkorpi, there are beautiful villages in the middle of traditional landscapes. You can ski, hike, bike, climb or look for geocaches and, above all, relax in the forest.

Sipoonkorpi is suitable for all ages all year round. The shortest route is the 1.4 km Byabäcken nature trail, which runs through the lush forests of Byabäcken and alongside pastures. For a true hiker, there are enough trails to hike on for several days.

Sipoonkorpi is easy to reach from all directions. There are several parking areas for those arriving by car, but the most wooded forest in Finland is also easily accessible by bicycle. In the 2025 summer season, hikers will also be served by the

Sipoonkorpi Hop-On Hop-Off bus on the weekends. The last stops are Tikkurila's travel centre and Mellunmäki metro station.

The village of Hindsby has an entrance gate called Korvenportti, whose services will provide you with unforgettable nature experiences and a break from everyday life, both for day trips and longer stays.





Archipelago



Blue glistening water, deserted windswept cliffs and delicacies from the harbour kiosk. Sipoo has a large archipelago with several recreational areas for everyone to enjoy.

Enjoy snacks by a campfire, canoe to the sandy beach on a hot day, enjoy the sun on a SUP board in the coastal waters or snare the catch of a lifetime.

Sipoo's archipelago can also be reached without a boat. You can easily get there on ferries, rental boats, rental kayaks or even jet skis.



Destinations in the archipelago

Sipoo archipelago has several outdoor recreational areas where you can find fireplaces for preparing barbecue delicacies, with dining groups and clean toilets.

Norrkullalandet

Norrkullalandet is Sipoo's archipelago's most popular excursion destination. It can be reached by free-to-board ferries, operated by Pörtö Line from the mainland to Norrkullaland up to four times a day! Enjoy the sun on several rocky and sandy beaches as well as grilling summer delicacies at barbecue sites. Walk on a nature trail to the observation tower from where you can see the entire Sipoo archipelago all the way to the open sea.

Möholmen

This popular excursion destination in Möholmen is located right next to Kalkkiranta harbour. Magnificent cliffs and sandy beaches await you.

There is plenty of space for campers, and there are wonderful views from the high cliffs. The sheltered cove is perfect for water games, even with younger children.

It is easy to land in Möholmen by small boat. You can just drag it to a sandy beach.

Vilstrand, Söderkullalandet

Sipoo municipality's recreational centre located closest to the mainland is easily accessible. You can get there by rowing or kayaking from Gumbostrand harbour. An overnight stay is possible not only in a tent, but also under a big canopy, which can shelter even a larger group from the rain. The tent can be set up facing the sunset on the island of Simsalö or to wake up to the first rays of the morning sun.

Östholmen

Östholmen is a destination for the whole family in the outer archipelago, where you can spend time playing either on a day trip or staying overnight in a tent. The island is a popular place for boaters.

The best way to get to Östholmen is by boat. When the weather is really good, you can also kayak along the sandy beach.

Many people think that the most beautiful sunsets can be seen in Östholmen. Tip: see the rocks on the west side!

Furuholmen

The pearl of the outer archipelago with wonderful open sea views!

Furuholmen is in a really windy place in Sipoonselkä, but the landing site is located in a sheltered lagoon. Even with a larger boat, you can still get ashore because the water is deep enough for even sailing boats on both sides of the jetty.

Simsalö

Simsalö is one of the longest inhabited islands in the Sipoo archipelago with a significant local population centre since the Middle Ages. Simsalö has always been important as a regional centre. Today, about 20 families live on the island all year round.

Until well into the 20th century, Simsalö's role as a provider of education in southern Sipoo was paramount as children from the coast along the mainland also came to Simsalö to attend school. Simsalö has retained its importance as a regional centre to this day, even though the majority of the inhabitants are summer residents.

Culture and art

Sipoo has been inhabited since the Stone Age and has had permanent settlements since at least the 9th century. The Sipoo of the 2020s is a vibrant cultural parish, which is proud of its roots but constantly evolving. We stick to our traditions, but keep our eyes boldly on the future.

Landscape of the eastern Jokipuisto

Helsinki's large mental hospital in Sipoo was a place to which the most difficult and sick patients were transferred. Many lived in the hospital for years, some until the end of their life. The hospital stopped operating in 1999, but you can still walk around the culturally and historically valuable hospital hill among the old art nouveau buildings, on paths trodden by thousands of patients.

Please note that the area is now a residential area and the houses are people's homes. Respect the residents and do not go into private gardens or stairways. Please also leave your car parked outside the area in a public parking space. Move around the area on foot.



Culture-Sipoo

Experience Sipoo's vibrant, unique and diverse cultural life. Regionalism, music, theatre, art and various experiences are offered all year round in two languages. All sorts of unexpected things can happen!

On event weekends, you can experience how the municipality is teeming with life and there might be unexpected and entertaining events awaiting you in one of the villages.

Churches and museums

Sipoo is an exceptional municipality in the sense that there are two magnificent churches located right next to each other in the centre of Nikkilä. The churches are only a few hundred metres apart and together they form a unique cultural landscape.



Churches in Sipoo

The Old Church of Sipoo, also known as St. Sigfrid's Church, was built in the 1450s. The medieval grey stone church is very popular as a wedding venue during the summer, and summer worship services are also held there. The designer of the church is unknown, but he is known as the so-called Master of Pernaja.

In the Old Church, you can still feel the atmosphere of the Middle Ages. The walls and vaults are decorated with paintings made with red ochre and soot in the 1400s. The church also houses the stocks from the church hall and the stool of repentance from the armoury (entrance hall), which date from the 1600s and 1700s.

The newer Sipoo Church, designed by Theodor Decker, is a mostly neo-Gothic style red brick church. It was built when the old church became too small for the growing congregation in the 1800s. The church was consecrated in 1885 and is used by both the Finnish- and Swedish-speaking congregations of Sipoo.

Museum of Agriculture

The Museum of Agriculture is located in a former granary next to Sipoo Church. The museum exhibits farming and other equipment from a time when the tractor and other machines had not yet replaced the horse. The museum opened its doors to the public in July 1983. It is open on the second Sunday of June, July and August from 13:00 to 16:00. No entrance fee. The museum is managed by Sibbo Hembygdsförening rf.

School Museum

The Sipoo School Museum moved to the Martinkylän koulu building in 2014. The building also houses the Sipoon opisto Adult Education Centre. The long history of the building gives a good insight into Sipoo's school culture and its development. The museum features one room furnished as an old-fashioned classroom, where visitors can do schoolwork from the old days, and a hallway with a large amount of material from different decades. Cycling routes

Sipoo is a beautifully diverse municipality where the countryside enchants with its undulating landscapes. The area has two gravel trails and the first long bikepacking route in Finland and the Nordic countries: **the South by Cycle bikepacking trail.**

Sipoonkorpi is crossed by about 30 km of gravel/sand and outdoor trails, which are ideal for an overnight ride. Another 50-km-long trail starts at Söderkulla and provides a varied view of Sipoo. Most of the trail is paved, and it is sandy only in some places. The trail winds through the hilly and charming countryside and coastal roads of Sipoo. It is worth slowing down to admire the scenery.

South by Cycle is a nearly 900-kilometre-long cycling route that stretches from Kouvola all the way to Hanko – part of the route passes through Sipoo. In Sipoo, the route is also close to the Talma climbing park and Sipoonjoki smoke sauna. Sipoonkorpi has a lean-to, renovated in 2022, a cook house and a toilet right next to Fiskträsk. Ängesböle is also a nice dry-land lean-to with a particularly beautiful gravel road leading to it.

Hop-On Hop-Off bus

The Sipoonkorpi Hop-On Hop-Off bus takes hikers to nature from May to October. The bus travels around Sipoonkorpi on Saturdays and Sundays on route Nikkilä, Tikkurila and Mellunmäki, stopping at a total of fifteen stops. Travelling on the line is easier than ever, as it is operated



with HSL tickets and can be found in the HSL route guide. The Sipoonkorpi Hop-On Hop-Off bus number is 899 and Sipoonkorpi National Park is part of HSL zones B, C and D.

The transport company, Taksikuljetus Harri Vuolle Oy, operates the route with a low-floor bus. It's easy to bring a baby stroller, and you can also take your dog or bicycle on board. The service is a cooperation between the Municipality of Sipoo and the City of Vantaa.
